**SUBJECT: Situation Report #1 on Tornadoes**

Tornadoes and thunderstorms have caused damage in southeastern Wisconsin this afternoon.

Walworth County Emergency Management reports at least two homes were damaged as well as farm buildings when a tornado apparently hit in southern Walworth County. No reports of any injuries. There are some roads closed.

Another tornado apparently has hit the Union Grove area in Racine County. There are reports of semi-trucks blown over. Some parts of I-94 were closed due to debris. There are also reports of structural damage.

Wisconsin Emergency Management has activated the State Emergency Operations Center. Staff are on the way to the damage areas.

Wisconsin Emergency Management will continue to monitor the weather and will provide updates as the situation changes. There has been no request for state assistance.
