A third heat-related death has been confirmed by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services. According to the Marquette County Coroner, an 80 year old Illinois man who was staying at his secondary home in Marquette County died during last week's extreme heat wave. Officials say the man did have underlying health issues. He apparently collapsed after spending time outside in the heat.

Wisconsin Emergency Management continues to monitor the situation for heat related issues and other events.
