## Latest Information on Severe Storms

### Situation Report #3 6/18/14

**Weather Update** – A second major line of severe storms swept across southern Wisconsin Wednesday morning. This storm triggered a Tornado Warning for Dane and Jefferson counties in southern Wisconsin but no touchdown was reported. Multiple trees and power lines were down from La Crosse to Madison to the Milwaukee metro area due to strong winds. Fortunately no major damage or injuries are reported at this time.

The National Weather Service now confirms six tornados touched down across southern Wisconsin during the late evening and early morning hours of June 16-17, 2014.

- Two (2) EF-1 and EF-3 tornados in Dane County.
- Two (2) EF-1 and EF-2 tornadoes in Grant County.
- Two (2) EF-1 tornadoes in Green County.

**Outages** – Here is a summary of power outages as of 10am this morning.
