HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM

- ◆ Grants to *state/local governments* to eliminate or reduce future damages
- ◆ Grants
 - 75% FEMA
 - 12.5% State
 - 12.5% local match
- ◆ Statewide

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- ◆ Either on public or private property
 - ◆ Acquisition/relocation of structures
 - ◆ Retrofitting such as floodproofing and elevation
 - ◆ Wind resistant retrofit construction
 - ◆ Safe Rooms and Community Storm Shelters
 - ◆ NOAA weather radios
 - ◆ Structural hazard control, i.e., detention basins, small floodwalls
 - ◆ Development or update of All-hazard mitigation plans
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REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ FEMA approved hazard mitigation plan
- ◆ Cost-Beneficial
- ◆ Environmentally Sound
- ◆ Considered other alternatives
- ◆ Best alternative
- ◆ Solve the problem

APPLICATION PROCESS

- ◆ Pre-Application
- ◆ WEM Review
- ◆ Score and Rank Pre-Applications
- ◆ Formal Application
 - Cost/Benefit Analysis
 - Environmental Concerns
- ◆ Applications submitted to FEMA within one year of declaration
