

Volk Field Facts

If you are a student planning to stay at Volk Field, here are some helpful facts to make your visit more enjoyable.

Volk Field Base Policies:

Vehicle seat-belt use is mandatory. Motorcyclists must wear a helmet and an orange safety vest at all times when riding on base. Bicyclists must also wear helmets at all times, and a reflective orange safety vest between the times of dawn and dusk.

No tobacco use inside ANY building, including the "Runway's Edge" (base club). Smoking is permitted at designated areas outside.

Volk Field Cellular Phone Use Policies:

The U.S. Department of Defense prohibits the use of cellular telephones while driving a vehicle on any military base.

Volk Field Firearms Policy:

Non-law enforcement officers: Privately owned weapons kept in lodging, work areas, dining facilities, privately owned vehicles and government vehicles is prohibited.
Civilian law enforcement officers: Privately owned weapons and weapons utilized for training on Volk must be stored in a locked case in their vehicle when/if not used in a training role.

Lodging:

Students must bring their own bath supplies, such as soap and shampoo.

Checkout time is at 9:00 a.m. on the last day of class.

Every effort will be made to house students in the Conference Center; however, occasionally students may be lodged outside of the Conference Center due to space availability. All rooms (in every building) are equipped with a television, telephone, refrigerator, and microwave.

Meals:

Meals and breaks may be included during your stay. When available, meals are served by private caterer at the Runway's Edge.

Dining Hours:

Breakfast: 7:00 – 8:00 a.m.
Lunch: 11:30 – 12:30 p.m.
Dinner: 5:30 – 6:00 p.m.

- Open 24 hours
- Equipment: treadmills, stair-steppers, stationary bikes, free weights, and total-stations.

ATM:

ATMs for public use are located in the lobby of the Conference Center and at the Runway's Edge (base pub).

Base Exchange (BX):

Students are allowed to use the BX for basic items, such as towels, sweatshirts, snack items, etc. Alcohol and tobacco may not be purchased by students unless they possess a valid military ID.

BX Hours: 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Weekdays

When on base, the last four digits can be used for all on-base calls. Phone numbers below are listed as calling from off-base.

Calling from off base to a student room:

Dial 608-427-1000 then enter the 4 digit room number:

- Conference center 1st floor = 1 + room number (example: room 135 would be extension #1135)
- Conference center 2nd floor = 2 + room number (example: room 235 would be extension #2235)
- Other lodging: Building number + room number (example: bldg 448, room 2 would be ext. #4482)
- *Buildings 118-133:* substitute "8" as the first digit of the building number (example: bldg 125, room 2 would be extension #8252)

Internet Access:

Internet access at Volk Field is available if students bring their own laptops, and their ISP can be accessed via a toll-free number. A local service provider also can be used for a daily fee of \$10. Students may also be able to briefly use terminals located at the Family Resource Center, located in building 360, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call SGT Garvin at extension #1715 if you plan to use this service.
